

## Investment Objectives and Policies

The Fund is an index-tracking exchange traded fund which seeks to provide investment returns, before fees and expenses, that closely correspond to the performance of the Underlying Index. The Fund will adopt a representative sampling strategy and hold a representative sample of the constituent securities of the Underlying Index ("Index Securities") selected by the Manager using quantitative methods to derive a portfolio sample

#### Manager's Comment ▲

The CSI Hong Kong Listed Tradable Mainland Real Estate Index was up in May.

Among 70 medium and large sized cities in April, the sale prices of newly constructed commercial residential buildings declined month-on-month (MoM) in 8 cities and increased in 58 cities, the other 4 cities remained the same. The largest increase was 2.3%, and the lowest was a decline of 1.2%. Relative to the same month of last year, the largest increase was 28.4%, and the lowest recorded a decline of 1.1%. The sales of commercial buildings in the first four months of 2017 registered an increase of 20.1% year-on-year (YoY). In particular, the sales of residential buildings increased by 16.1% YoY, office buildings up by 50.4% YoY, and buildings for commercial business up by 41.4% YoY.

According to the National Bureau of Statistics, the Consumer Price Index increased 1.2% YoY in April; the prices grew by 1.3% in cities and 0.8% in rural areas. Food price went down by 3.5%, and the non-food prices increased by 2.4%.

As of May 31, the NAV per unit of the Fund was HKD8.2246, and the CSI Hong Kong Listed Tradable Mainland Real Estate Total Return Index closed at 1069.5404.
